Windows 7 Wireless Instructions

- 1. Check to make sure that your wireless adapter is turned on:
 - a. Go to Start Menu and click Control Panel.



b. Click Network and Internet.



c. Click Network and Sharing Center.



d. In the <u>Network and Sharing Center</u> navigation window click on <u>Change Adapter Settings</u>.



e. Right Click on your wireless adapter icon and choose Enable <u>if</u> the adapter has been disabled.



- 2. Check to make sure that your wireless adapter is configured for automatic IP configuration and automatic DNS configuration:
 - a. Right click on your wireless adapter icon and choose Properties.



b. Select Internet Protocol Version 4 (TCP/IPv4) then click the Properties button.



c. On the General Tab be sure that the radio buttons for <u>Obtain an IP address</u> <u>automatically</u> and the radio button for <u>Obtain DNS server address automatically</u> are selected.



d. Click on the <u>Alternate Configuration</u> tab and check that the radio button for <u>Automatic</u> <u>private IP address</u> is checked. Click OK on both windows to close.



- 3. Now Connect to the Boston Public Library wireless:
 - a. Right click on the wireless adapter and click on Connect/Disconnect.



b. Click the Boston Public Library SSID and click Connect.
