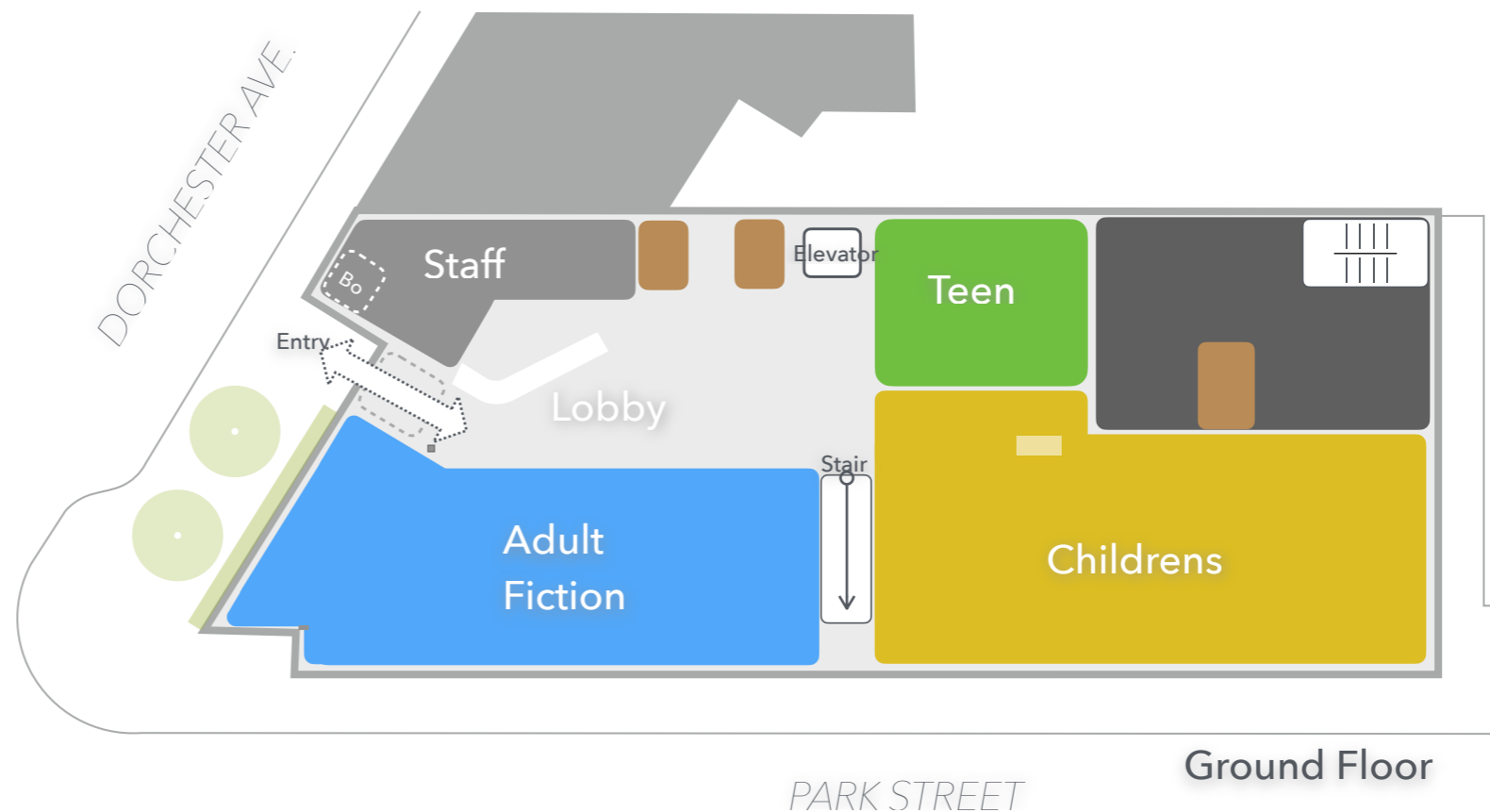
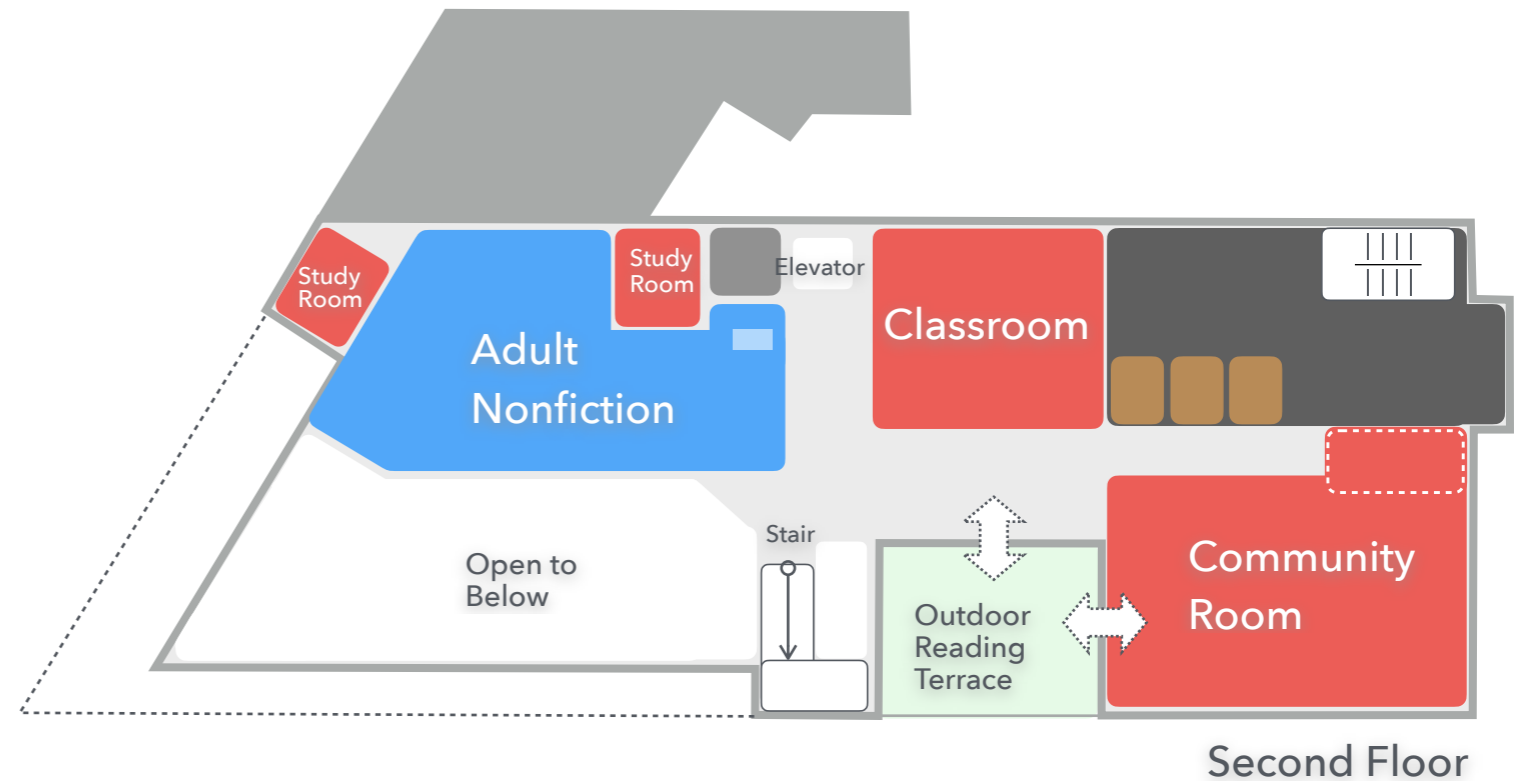


Building Design Schedule



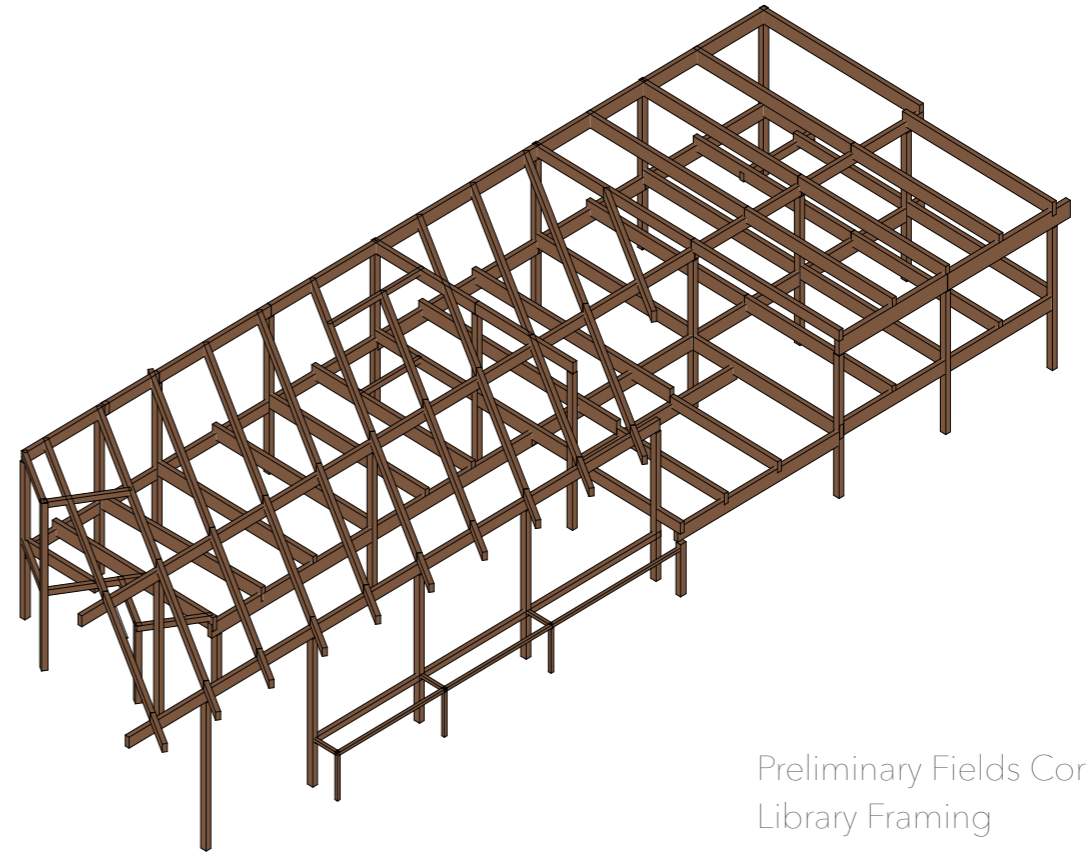
Community Meeting #2 Recap

- Reviewed Plan Diagrams, Building Massing and Sustainability Goals
- New library will be 14,500 square feet and will be two stories
- Community program includes a 100-seat flexible meeting room, a 20-person classroom, and two study rooms
- Outdoor space includes plantings and seating at the entry and a second floor outdoor reading terrace.



Community Meeting #2 Recap

- Timber structure
- Designed to City of Boston Zero Net Carbon (ZNC) standard and will be an all-electric building (fossil fuel free)
- Designed for future PV installation
- Targeting LEED Gold Certification

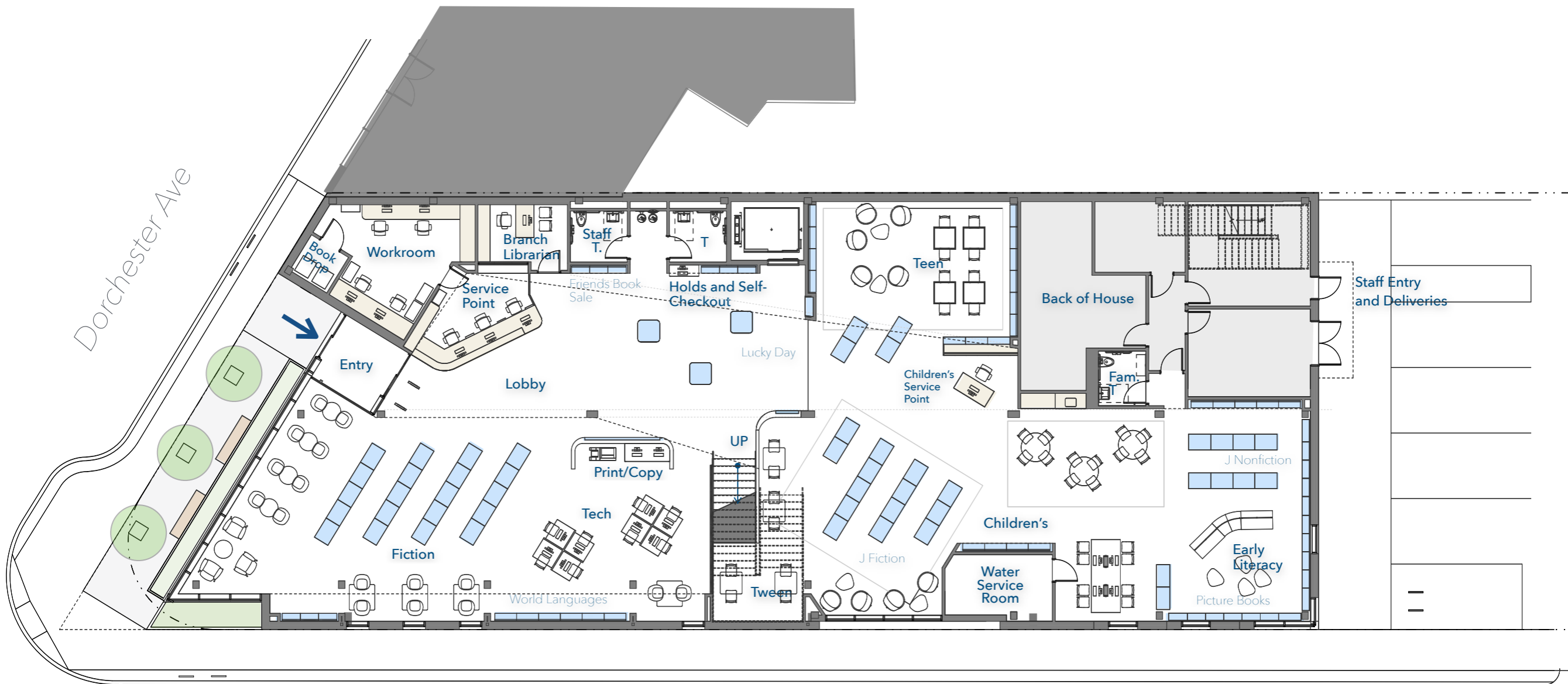

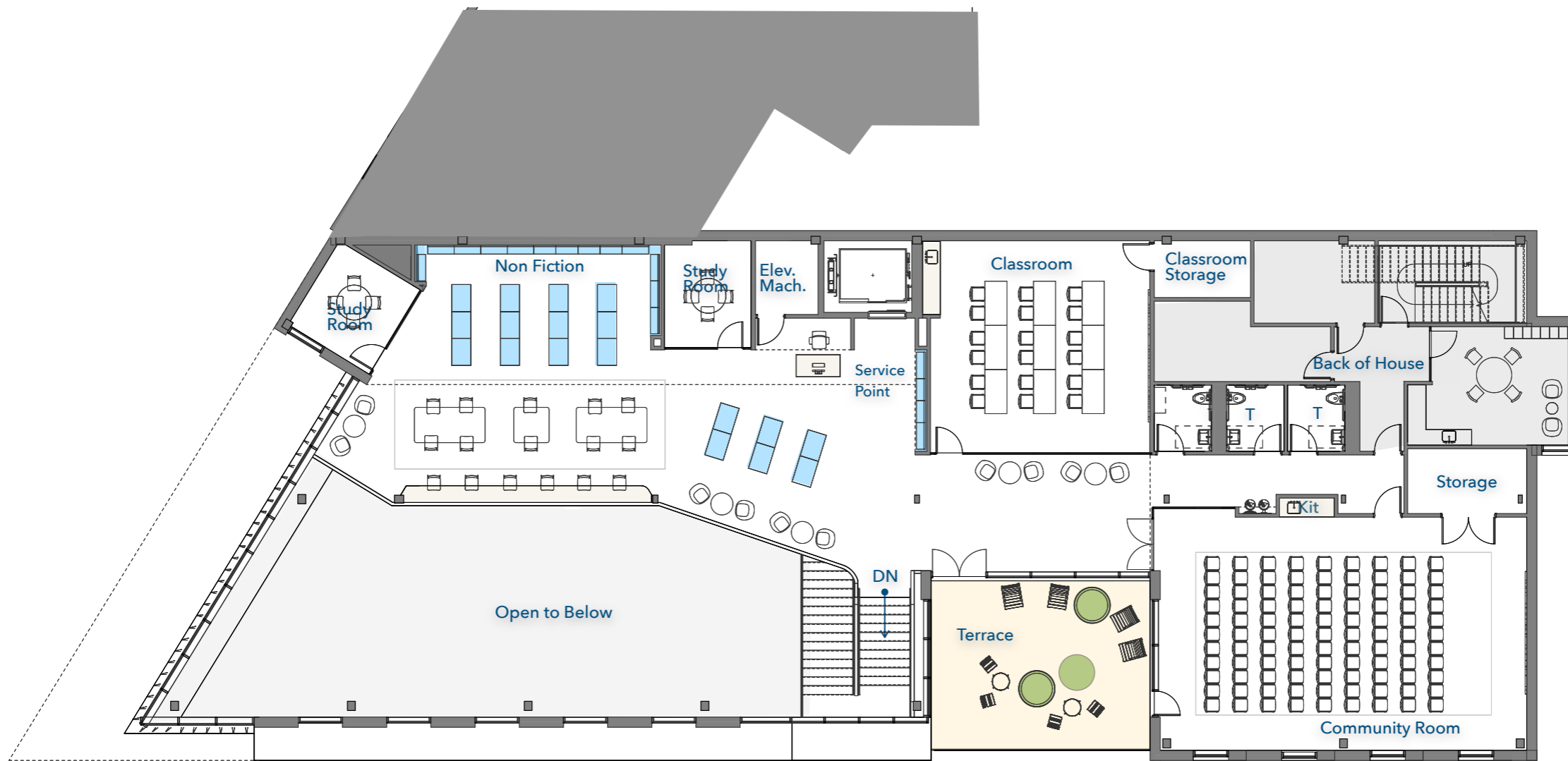




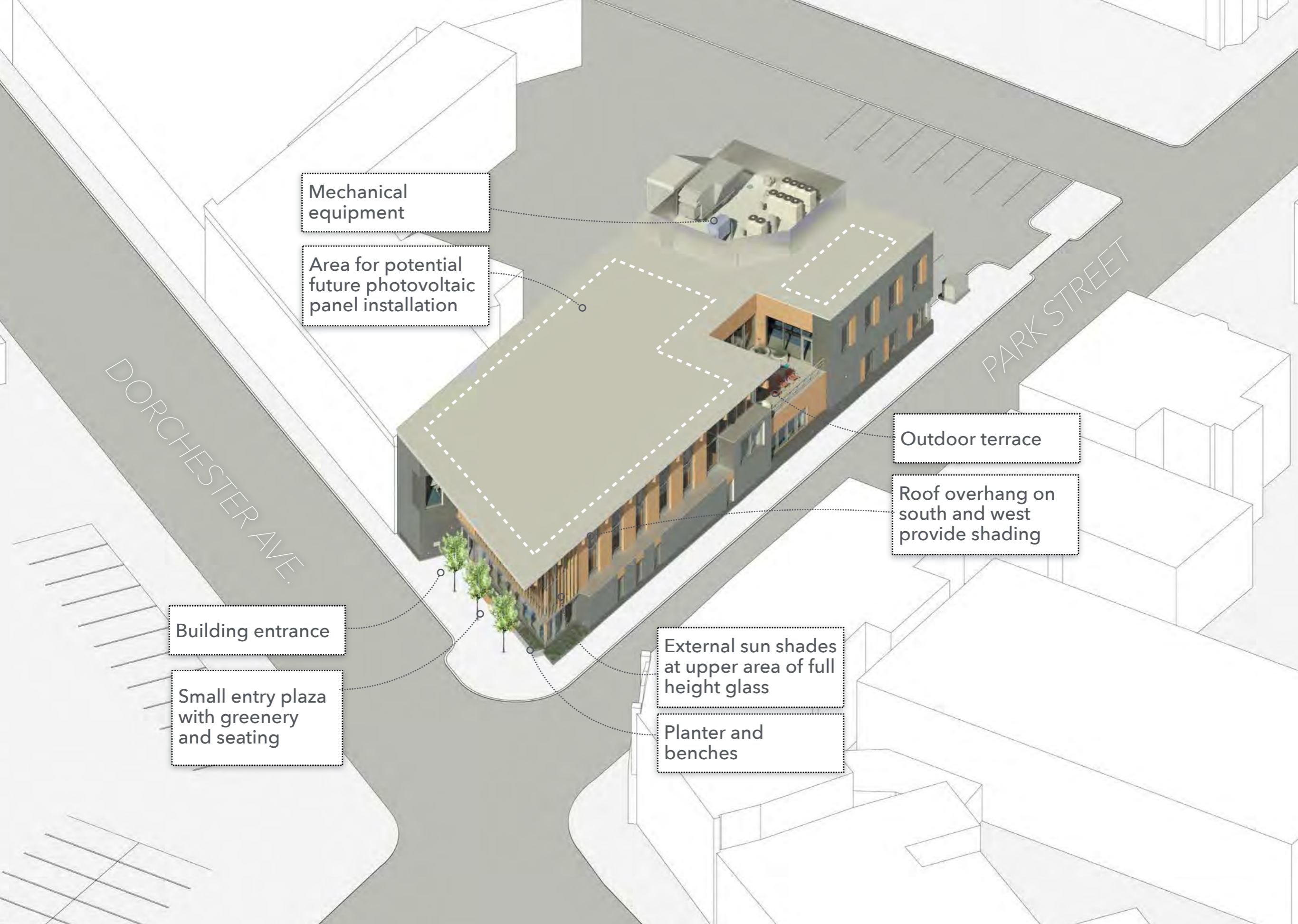
Park Street

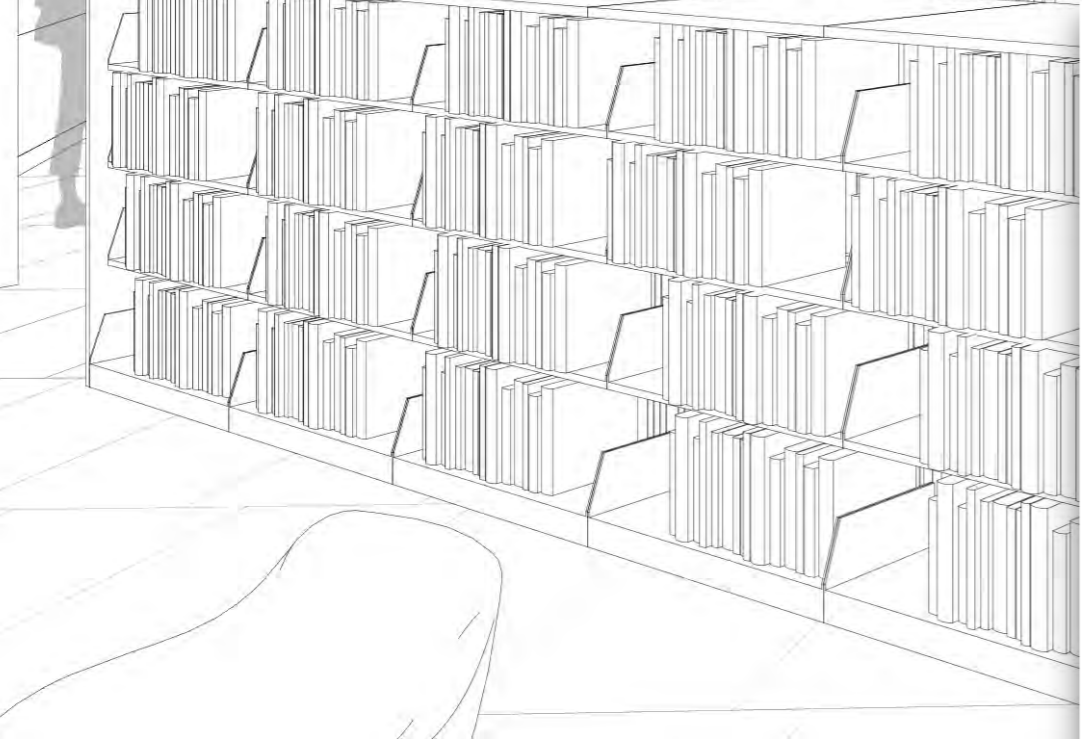
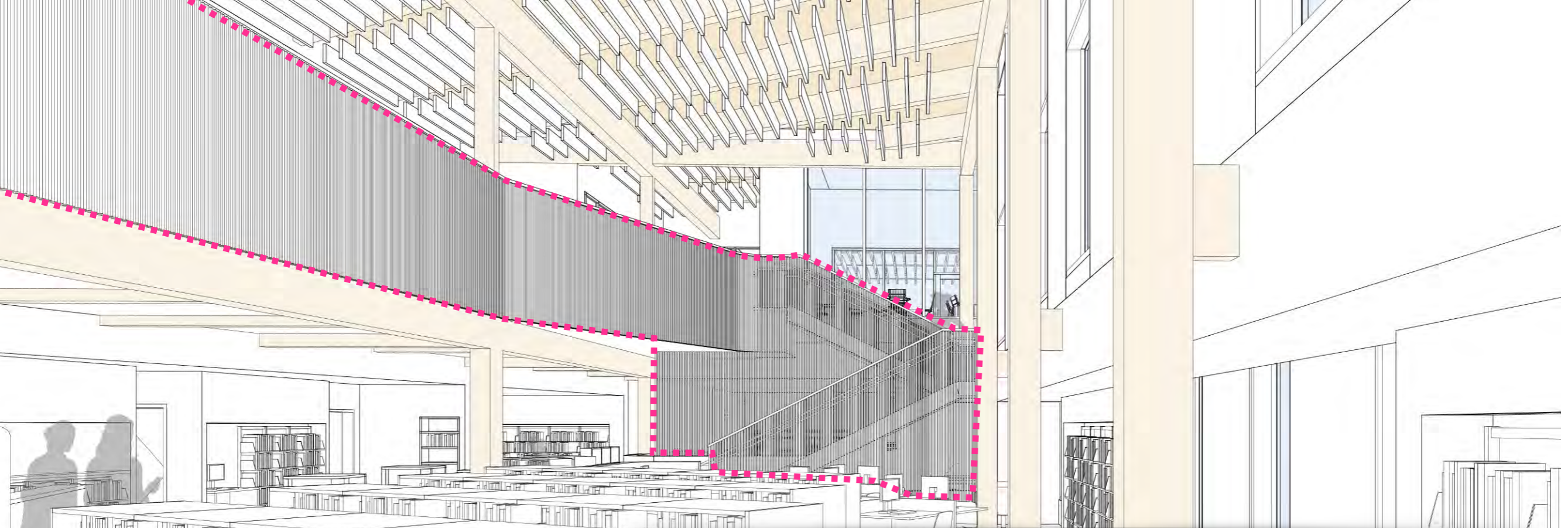


Exposed Timber Structure



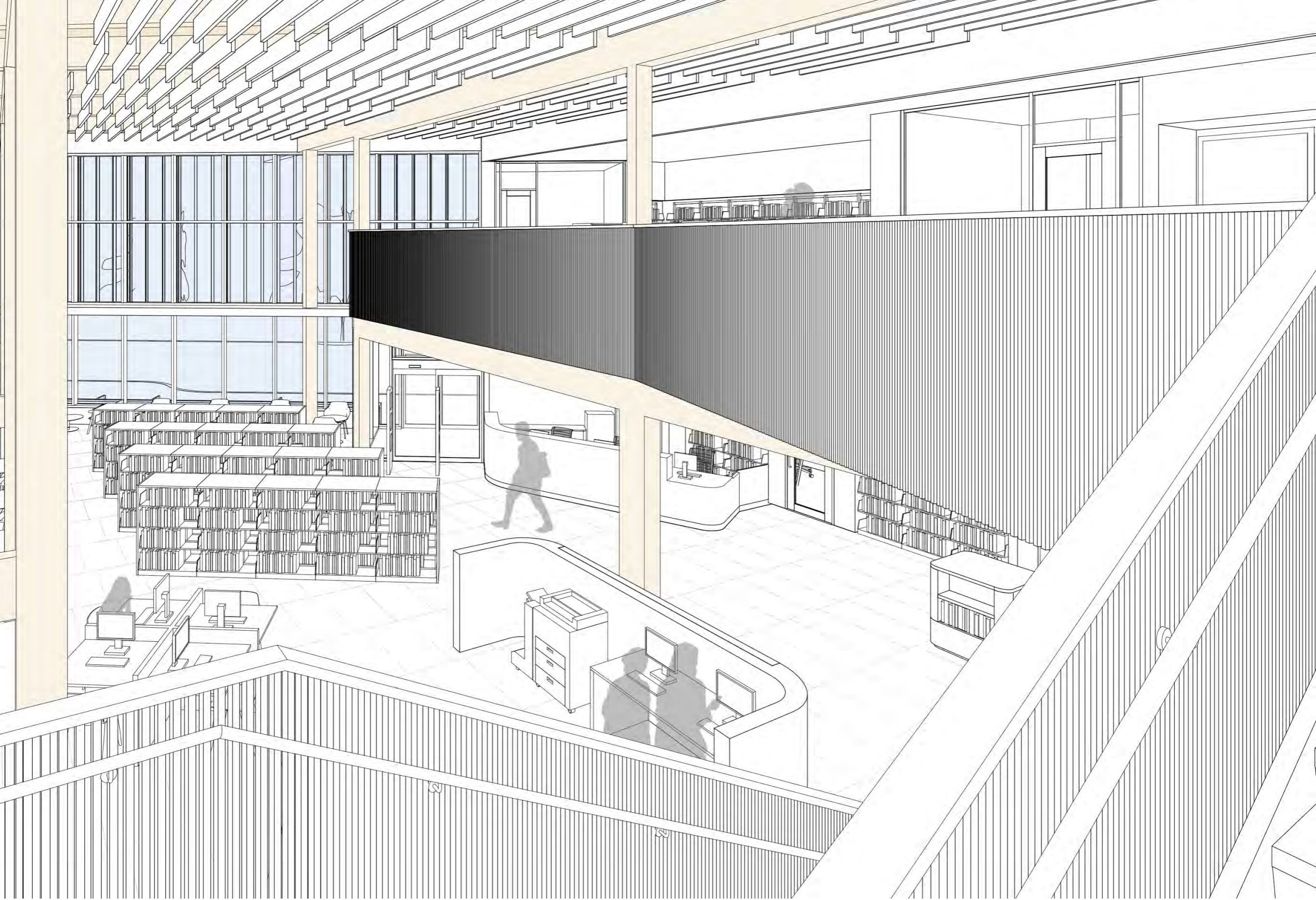

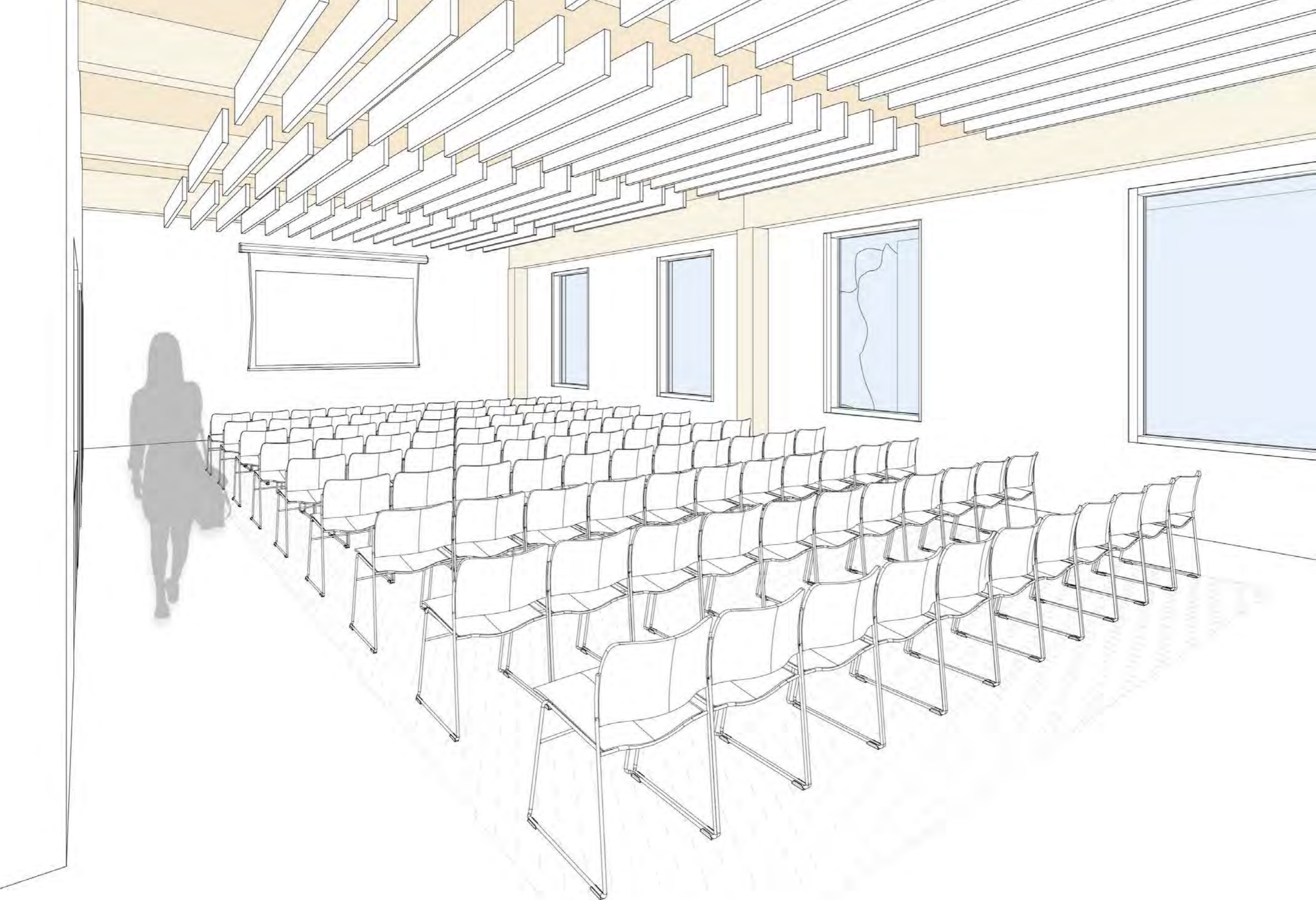

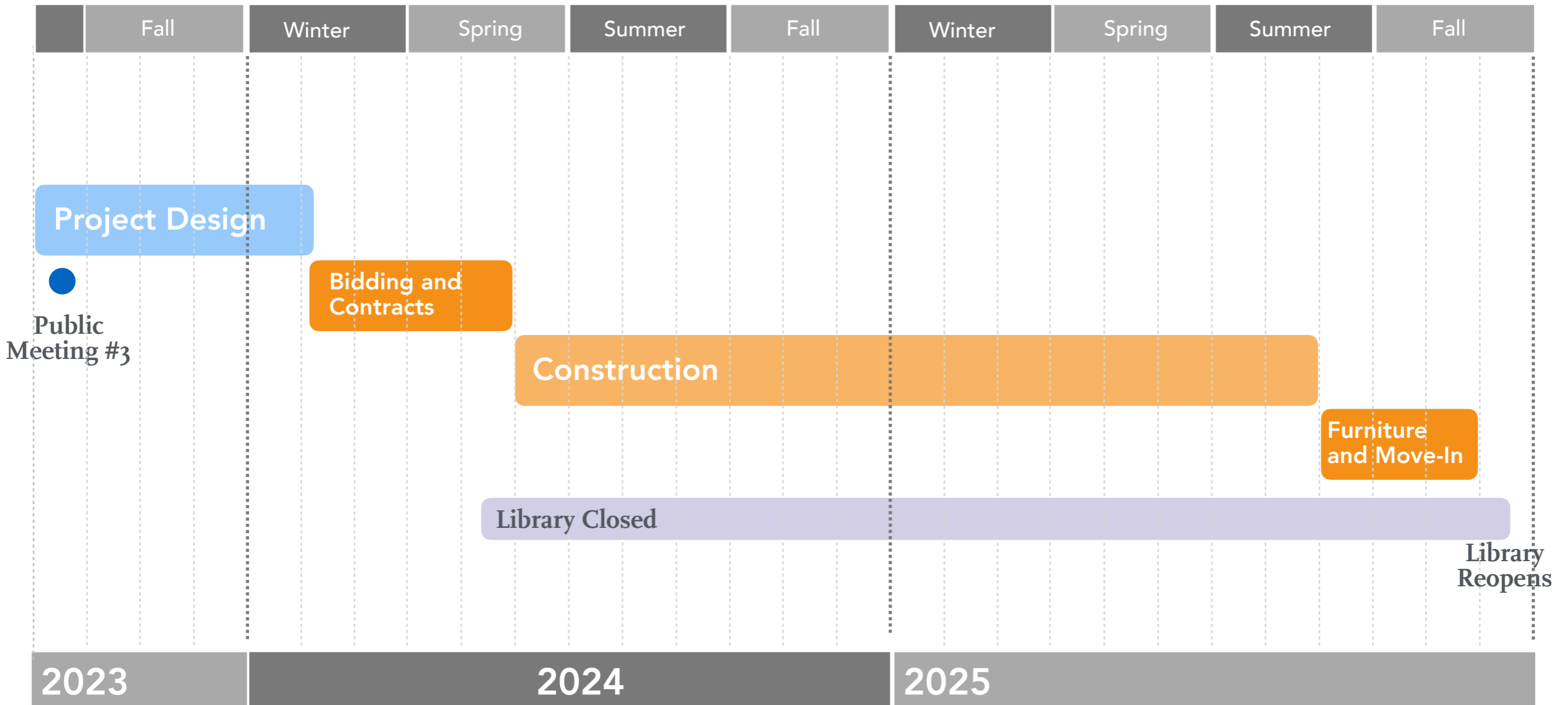
